Wyoming County Community Fund 2023 Scholarship Grant Proposal Guidelines

General Information

This scholarship grant is intended to support higher academic pursuits in Wyoming County.

Grants are awarded to:

- 1. Students attending a Wyoming County High School **Or**
- Wyoming County students currently enrolled at the Wyoming County Career & Technical Center or the Wyoming/McDowell County Campus of Southern WV Community & Technical College Or
- 3. Wyoming County adults returning to school.
- 4. Wyoming County adults with an ABE Certificate.
- 5. Must be a Wyoming County resident.

(In all cases, the awardee must attend or plan to attend the Wyoming County Career & Technical Center or Southern WV Community & Technical College Wyoming/McDowell County Campus.)

Grant Amounts:

This scholarship grant is for \$1,250 to be used for the Fall 2023, and \$1,250 to be used for the Spring 2024 academic semester.

One Scholarship will be awarded.

About The Wyoming County Community Fund

The Wyoming County Community Fund (WCCF) is a sustainable source of funds built to serve the needs of Wyoming County for years to come. Eligibility Criteria

- Any high school or college student must possess a 2.5 or greater cumulative GPA.
- Document prior work experience, examples of community service and/or completion of ABE requirements.
- The applicant cannot be on probation of any kind.
- The use of this scholarship grant must be used for the Fall 2023 Spring 2024 term.
- Applicants must submit one original proposal and one copy.
- The intent of this scholarship is to be a one-time grant. It will not be repeated for ongoing needs.
- This scholarship will be awarded to the Wyoming County Career & Technical Center or Southern WV Community & Technical College Wyoming/McDowell County Campus in the name of the recipient of the scholarship.
- The recipient must register as a full-time student at the Wyoming County Career & Technical Center or Southern WV Community & Technical College Wyoming/McDowell County Campus.
- The recipient must maintain a 2.5 GPA to receive the Spring 2024 award.
- Wyoming County Community Fund or Wyoming County Planning Commission Members who may have a conflict must recuse themselves from the selection process.
- Grants are not awarded to or for:
 - Paying off student loans

Scholarship Grant Narrative

"What ideas would you have to help stimulate the economy in Wyoming County?"

- Official Transcript and/or ABE scores
- Any additional information that supports your application (Optional)

Submission & Review

Provide <u>one</u> original and <u>one</u> copy of your entire proposal for the review committee.

All scholarship grant requests must be postmarked or delivered to the Wyoming County EDA office at one of the addresses below by *4:00pm on April 14, 2023*.

The review process may include a phone interview by the Scholarship Application Committee. Grant award notification will take place 4-8 weeks from the proposal deadline.
